

YOU CAN HELP STOP MEDICAID FRAUD, WASTE AND ABUSE

Examples of Medicaid Fraud and Waste include:

- Providing unnecessary services.
- > Billing for medical services not actually performed.
- Billing for unnecessary services.
- > Billing more than once for the same service.
- Billing separately for services that legitimately should be one billing.
- Dispensing generic drugs but billing for brand-name drugs.
- Giving or accepting something of value (kickbacks), such as cash, gifts, or services, in return for medical services.
- > Falsifying cost reports or claims.

Examples of Medicaid Abuse include:

- When someone lies about their medical condition.
- When someone lies about their eligibility.
- When someone forges prescriptions.
- > When someone loans their Medicaid card to others.
